PETITION TO DETERMINE PATERNITY

COMES NOW the Secretary of the Kansas Department for Children and Families by and through MARK D. MCMILLAN, STAFF ATTORNEY and states:

1. That this action is brought pursuant to K.S.A. Chapter 60, K.S.A. 23-2201, et seq., K.S.A. 39-755 or 39-756 and K.S.A. 39-718b.

2. That the petitioner is exempt from paying a docket fee pursuant to K.S.A. 60-2005.

3. That JENNIFER L. SCHREINER is the natural mother of the minor child and that JENNIFER L. SCHREINER is the guardian and next friend of the minor child.

4. That the respondent, WILLIAM MAROTTA, is the father of MIA L. BAUER-SCHREINER, year of birth 2009, and owes a duty to support said child and may be served in accordance with the Praecipe for Service attached hereto.

5. That the support rights for the above named child have been assigned to the Secretary of the Kansas Department for Children and Families pursuant to K.S.A. 39-709 or 39-756.

6. That the Department for Children and Families has expended cash assistance in the amount of \$189.00 for the time period of July 2012 through September 2012 and medical assistance in the amount

of \$5,884.96 and the respondent is liable to repay said amounts to the Department for Children and Families pursuant to K.S.A. 39-718b.

7. That the mother of said child has incurred expenses for the support, education and medical care of the child and the respondent is liable to repay said amounts or a portion thereof to the mother.

WHEREFORE, petitioner prays that the court enter an order adjudicating the respondent, WILLIAM MAROTTA, to be the father of the child, MIA L. BAUER-SCHREINER, year of birth 2009, and directing that if the determination of paternity is at variance with the child's birth certificate that a new birth certificate be issued.


FURTHER petitioner prays that the court enter an order of child support against the respondent pursuant to the Kansas Child Support Guidelines and for an order requiring the respondent to provide or share in the cost of medical insurance for the minor child and to pay or share in any uncovered medical, dental, orthodontic, optometric, or other health related expenses.

FURTHER petitioner prays that judgment for expenses for the support of the child be granted to the Secretary of the Kansas Department for Children and Families for the period of July 2012 through September 2012 in the amount of \$189.00 and for birth and medical expenses of the child in the amount of \$5884.96; plus such additional sums as may be expended prior to the date of judgment.

FURTHER petitioner prays that judgment be granted to the mother to reimburse the expenses of support and education of the minor child and to reimburse for the necessary medical expenses related to the birth of the child.

FURTHER petitioner prays that the respondent be ordered to pay the costs of this action including, but not limited to, court costs and genetic test fees and for such other relief as the court deems just and equitable.
