

LAW OF ST. PETERSBURG

On Introducing Amendments to the Law of St. Petersburg on "Administrative offenses in St. Petersburg"

Adopted by
the Legislative Assembly
of St. Petersburg
on February 29, 2012

Article 1

To introduce into the Law of St. Petersburg of May 12, 2012 No. 273-70 "On administrative offenses in St. Petersburg" the following changes:

1. Add Articles 7_1 and 7_2 reading as follows:

"Article 7_1. Public actions aimed at propaganda of sodomy, lesbianism, bisexuality, transgenderism amongst minors

Public actions aimed at propaganda of sodomy, lesbianism, bisexuality, transgenderism amongst minors incur an administrative fine for citizens in the amount of five thousand rubles; for officials – fifty thousand rubles; for legal entities – from two hundred fifty thousand to five hundred thousand rubles.

Note. As public actions aimed at propaganda of sodomy, lesbianism, bisexuality, transgenderism amongst minors in this article should be understood activities on purposeful and uncontrolled dissemination of information in a publicly accessible way that can be harmful to the health, moral and spiritual development of minors, including forming in their mind a distorted perception of social equality of traditional and nontraditional marital relationships.

Article 7_2. Public actions aimed at propaganda of pedophilia

Public actions aimed at propaganda of pedophilia amongst minors incur an administrative fine for citizens in the amount of five thousand rubles; for officials – fifty thousand rubles; for legal entities – from five hundred thousand to one million rubles.

Note. As public actions aimed at propaganda of pedophilia amongst minors in this article should be understood activities on purposeful and uncontrolled

dissemination of information in a publicly accessible way aimed at forming in the society a distorted perception of the consistency with the social norms of intimate relationships between adults and minors."

2. In Article 48 paragraph 1 subparagraph 1 words "provisioned in the articles 6, 8, 8_4, 8_5, 12, 45, 46, 46_1" replace with words "provisioned in the articles 6, 7_1, 7_2, 8, 8_4, 8_5, 12, 45, 46, 46_1".

Article 2

The law of S. Petersburg takes effect in 10 days after the day of its official publication.
